Vaulted wood ceilings, walls of windows, bar seating, a built-in Blackstone... you'll start inventing reasons to invite people over. And then there's the garage. Three bays. Extra height for lifts. Enough room for the vehicles, the toys, the workshop, the gym, and probably that project you've been promising yourself you'd start for five years. If you're a car enthusiast, this might actually become your favourite room

in the house. Downstairs keeps the momentum going with a private theatre room, sleek bar, two additional bedrooms, and space that was designed to be enjoyed rather than simply occupied. All of this sits on 3.6 stunning acres that give you the breathtaking mountain views you've always wanted without sacrificing convenience. It's so close to town, the kids could ride their bikes to school! Here's the problem with this property: once you walk through it, every other house starts feeling a little... ordinary. So if you've ever wondered what life would be like inside the famous black house, it's time to stop wondering and book the showing. Fair warning: you're probably not going to want to leave.
