Built by Greystone Construction under the direction of Gaither Zinkan and proudly Built Green certified, the home showcases a spectacular timber frame handcrafted by International Timber Frame of Golden, British Columbia. Soaring Douglas Fir beams, solid Douglas Fir doors, trim and baseboards, expansive triple-pane wood-framed windows, and beautiful natural finishes create a warm, sophisticated mountain aesthetic designed to stand the test of time. A welcoming Rundle Stone entrance sets the tone for the exceptional quality found throughout. Inside, the great room is anchored by a striking wood-burning Rundle Stone fireplace, while a second gas fireplace creates a cozy gathering space in the walkout lower-level family room. Oak hardwood flooring, elegant limestone tile, travertine flooring in the primary suite, and a spa-inspired ensuite with a steam shower further elevate the home's thoughtful design. One of the home's most distinctive features is the open loft, where a private office overlooks the dramatic timber frame and captures sweeping Bow Valley views. Hidden within is a charming children's play retreat, creating a magical space for young imaginations while preserving the home's refined character. A temperature-controlled wine cellar with storage for more than 70 bottles adds yet another thoughtful touch. Outdoor living is

equally impressive. The composite rear deck, accented with Rundle rock from Thunderstone Quarries, overlooks the surrounding mountain landscape and wildlife corridor, offering the perfect place to entertain, relax, or enjoy the Beachcomber hot tub beneath the stars. Designed for exceptional year-round comfort, the home features central air conditioning, a three-zone forced-air heating system, a wall-mounted boiler supplying domestic hot water and extensive zoned in-floor heating, including the lower level, garage, kitchen, and main-floor bathrooms. Located just minutes from downtown Canmore, renowned trails, schools, exceptional dining, and world-class recreation, 215 Benchlands Terrace is more than an extraordinary home—it is a legacy property offering an unparalleled mountain lifestyle in one of the Canadian Rockies' most coveted locations.
